PROGRAMME

The Summer School, supported by the Foundation «Il Vittoriale degli Italiani», in Gardone Riviera (BS), gives classes, seminars, debates held and run by high qualified university professors. Classes, seminars, and debates are accompanied by integrative activities such as presentations given by students, guided tours in the Vittoriale archives, and visits to tourist-cultural places in the area.

Structure

Morning classes take place from Monday to Friday (three hours each morning) and have an interdisciplinary and comparative nature, focusing on Italian and European elements.

Students will be provided in advance with class materials in pdf as well as with the bibliography regarding class topics.

AFTERNOON SEMINARS will have a formative and specialized character, deepening an aspect linked to the morning lesson, with particular attention, but not exclusive to Gabriele d'Annunzio; seminars will also have a laboratory structure by means of the Vittoriale's documentary resources (libraries, archive of the manuscripts, etc.).

During the seminars, students will have an active role; they will have to elaborate presentations in oral and / or written form (the latter previously sent to the School secretary) under the supervision of a tutor.

Summer School Participants

Summer School courses, considered as linguistic and cultural study, are aimed at M.A. University Students, Italian and foreign Ph.D. Students, early post-doc researchers, as well as secondary school teachers interested in training and updating.

The knowledge levels for the Italian language: C1.

A linguistic training is planned to prepare the C2 certificate of the European framework; the course is authorized to issue this certification. At the end of the course a certificate of attendance is issued.

Course duration

The course lasts one week. On Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 excursions to cultural and tourist places on Garda Lake and to Venice are organized.

To participate, you must send your application to the Secretariat (email address) by attaching your curriculum vitae. The deadline is <u>February 28th</u>, <u>2020</u>.

Eventually the Summer School Office will let the candidates know the deadline for sending the transfer of the registration fee (500 euro) with all the indications of the referring Bank. The registration fee includes participation in all the activities of the School.

Course participants will be offered special rates for Alitalia and Ryanair flights on Verona and Bergamo.

5 scholarships are foreseen to cover either the registration fee or the accommodation for PhD students and post-doc. Scholarships will be assigned by a Commission.

The students may stay in affiliated hotels that will be indicated by the Summer School office along with all the necessary information.

The direction of the School is entrusted to the President of Vittoriale Giordano Bruno Guerri and to Professors Pietro Gibellini, Raffaella Bertazzoli, and Elena Ledda.
